ST TERESA BENEDICTA of the CROSS (9th August)

Edith Stein was born in Germany in 1891 into a Jewish family The youngest of 11. Edith became a catholic at 31 in 1922. Before she became a nun, she taught history and German but also gave talks about woman issues and love. She wrote 'I understood the Cross as the destiny of God's people'. 'The world does not need what you have but what you are'. She was captured by the Gestapo in 1942 and sent to Auchwitz where she died. Pope John Paul II at her canonisation said about her; We honour a daughter of Israel who during Nazi persecution remained united, as a catholic, in fidelity and love to the crucified Lord Jesus Christ, and, as a Jew, to her people.
