GOSPEL REFLECTION



Although the Dogma confirming that Mary was in fact assumed body and soul into heaven was only defined in 1954 by Pope Pius XII, but, in fact, he was only confirming what Catholics had held to be true for many centuries. Of course there is no biblical 'evidence' to prove that Mary did not suffer death like the rest of humanity, but then Mary was exceptional in so many ways, that it would seem appropriate to think that she was given special treatment when it was time for her to leave this earth. Mary's yes to the angel Gabriel to become the Mother of God was in itself an amazing proof of her total faith in God. She spent the whole of her life living the will of God to perfection even to the point of being at the foot

of the cross as Jesus breathed his last breath. She was so much imbued with the Word of God that already she was living the life of paradise on earth. She wants us to go to her when we are troubled. She wants to be our advocate before her son. At the wedding feast of Cana she asked Jesus to save the face of the hosts and then said to them: "Do whatever he tells you". She can help us to do whatever he tells us.

BROTHERS AND SISTERS ALL AN ABSENCE OF HUMAN DIGNITY ON THE BORDERS

41. I realize that some people are hesitant and fearful with regard to migrants. I consider this part of our natural instinct of self-defence. Yet it is also true that an individual and a people are only fruitful and productive if they are able to develop a creative openness to others. I ask everyone to move beyond those primal reactions because "there is a problem when doubts and fears condition our way of thinking and acting to the point of making us intolerant, closed and perhaps even – without realizing it – racist. In this way, fear deprives us of the desire and the ability to encounter the other".
