MY DEAR PARISHIONERS

Today is 24th Sunday of the Ordinary time.

Today is also called EDUCATION SUNDAY. It is a National Day of prayer and celebration for everyone in the world of Education.

The theme for this year is "A Word in Season" taken from Is.50:4.

It is an opportunity to give thanks to God for all who teach and all who study. As this day falls on September 12th, immediately after the beginning of the new academic year, let us keep our Christ the King School, its staff, and students in our prayers.

In tune with the document of our Bishop Mark "A precious place for God's grace", a new step forward is being planned by forming a New Parish Council in our parish to instil new blood and vitality into parish functioning, especially after the post Covid period. So, we, in the council meeting last week, have decided to dissolve the present Parish Council, and I hope to form and convene a New Parish Council by the second week of December, before the feast of Christmas.

I am on the lookout for fresh members and might approach you. Your valuable suggestions are solicited and welcomed.

Let us be reminded that Annual Mass Counts takes place on the final two weekends of September and First two weekends of October. And it does call for a rethinking on our physical participation in the Holy Mass and Sacraments especially in this post pandemic times for the sustainability of our parish.

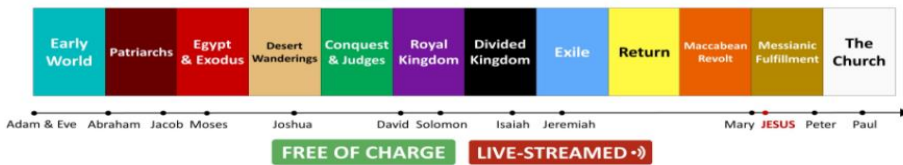
