# Our Faith on Sunday

**GOSPEL REFLECTION**

Emperor certainly had divine status. This high status was almost always abused by monarchs and used to keep them in power by suppressing anyone who might be a threat to that power. The Jews too, who had been expecting the Messiah, were hoping for a king who would lead them out of the oppression of the Roman empire. But, as Jesus says to Pontius Pilate in today's Gospel, his kingdom is not of this world. For the Jewish leaders who wanted to be rid of Jesus, to proclaim himself King of the Jews

was a blasphemy and an offence which merited execution. Jesus came to serve and not be served and his whole life gave witness to this. He associated with public sinners and people of ill-repute. He healed lepers and those on the margins of society. He asks his followers to do the same.

**HISTORY**

Pope Pius XI instituted the feast in his encyclical 'Quas Primas' in 1925. The feast was originally held on the last Sunday of the month of October. According to Pope Pius XI, once we recognise that Christ is King, we will at least receive the great blessing of real liberty, peace and harmony.

**REFLECTION**

Citizens of Christ's kingdom are expected to observe only one major law: the law of love, Love God with your whole heart and love your neighbour as yourself. If you love me, you will keep my commandments.

Jesus expects a higher degree of love from His followers. Love one another as I have loved you.

Let us resolve to give him the central place in our lives and promise to obey his commandment of love by sharing what we have with all his needy children

Today is Thirty Fourth Sunday of Ordinary time and it is the **FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING**. It is the Feast of our Church in Kinson, and is a day dedicated to remembering and pray for our School: Christ the King Primary School.

We are delighted to have strong links between our Parish of Christ the King and the school. Children at Christ the King participate in Mass both at Church and school. Earlier Our Lord had said that the church would be like yeast in dough (Mat:13:33) . The dough is the world. Jesus never promised that the world become yeast! The church (God's people) as yeast in the dough, should have a constant uplifting impact in the community in which it is situated, and testify to the truth! If you have an uplifting impact, wherever you are, and testify to the truth by word and example, you are establishing God's reign of which Jesus Christ is the Messiah, the Anointed King.

The process of Synodal journey in the Church, isn't it a clarion call by Pope Francis for an upliftment in the Church for the reign of God's Kingdom to the signs of the times, leading the Church in the first quarter of the third millennium?
