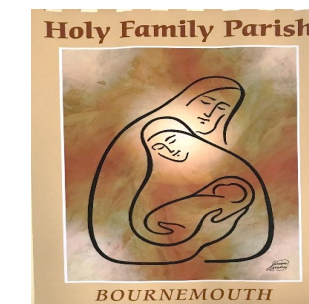

The Trinity is often treated like a mathematical and philosophical problem. No attempt to understand the intra-trinitarian relationships of the three Persons can get very far. The reading which the Church gives us, instead, gives an inkling of our triple relationship with God. The basis is Jesus' own prayer, in which he called God 'Abba', the dignified and affectionate word in Jesus' own language by which a son addressed his father. The staggering next move is that Jesus told us that we might use the same form of address; so we use it, even in Aramaic. It is, however, only because Christ has given us his Spirit as our spirit that we can do so. This Spirit is also the Spirit of the Father. Sometimes in the gospel it is Jesus, sometimes it is the Father who sends the Spirit. We can say that the Spirit gives us access to the Father and to the Son, or that the Father gives the Spirit of the Son, or that the Son gives us his Spirit.

In this way the Trinity, each Person in a different way, imparts to us the love of God and draws us into God's own love.

Today is the Feast of the **Most Holy Trinity!**

We shall have many of such joint gathering for holy mass together. Our next joint mass will be on 2nd of June, when we shall celebrate the First Holy Communion Day of our children.

Glenn's Ordination : At last the Cat is out! We have been waiting for this glad news since long wit prayers in our hearts. It has been now confirmed to be on 5th July , Friday at St. Mary's Poole. A Day for all of us to rejoice and be glad together with his family and friends.

Month of May is Month of Mary. The tradition of dedicating the month of May to Mary came in the 13th century. Mary gave new life to the world when she gave birth to our Saviour Jesus Christ.

Pope Francis clears path for the canonization of Blessed Carlo Acutis He was born in London, England, and died on October 12th 2006, at the age of 15. Pope Francis beatified him in 2022 at Assisi, where his body is kept in veneration. The miracle recognized on Thursday is related to a woman from Costa Rica.

Reflection : *At the Baptism of Jesus, as He came up out of the water, He saw heaven opening and the Spirit coming down on Him like a dove. And a voice came down from heaven, "You are my own dear Son and I am pleased with you"(Mk :1:9)*

A church in rural China was filled. Just as services were about to begin, an armed communist soldier entered. The Congregation grew alarmed. Seeing this, the soldier set them at ease, by making the Sign of the Cross, a Sign of his belief in the Most Holy Trinity, "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit".

Indeed, the Baptism of the Lord contains the most dramatic references to the Holy Trinity.

Father – Voice coming from the Heavens.
 Son – Jesus coming out of the water.
 Spirit – As Dove Coming down on Jesus.
